

EXPLORE THE GREAT OUTDOORS

1 OAK LEAF TRAIL

Scenery along the [Oak Leaf Trail](#) varies from woodland parks, nature reserves, and a wild-life corridor along the lakefront, to urban industrial settings in Milwaukee's downtown area. It's great for biking, rollerblading, or simply walking and enjoying the beautiful paths! (Free)

SEVEN BRIDGES TRAIL

Placed along the Lake Michigan lakeshore in Grant Park, about 10 minutes south of Downtown Milwaukee, [Seven Bridges Trail](#) offers beautiful scenery that seems like something out of a fairytale. Bring your camera and some hiking shoes and head through the trail to explore! (Free)

3 VETERANS PARK

[Veterans Park](#), along Lake Michigan's shore, offers a kite store, large open grassy areas, a section of the paved Oak Leaf Trail, and a 14-acre lagoon with paddle boat rentals. (Free)

ATWATER BEACH

[Atwater Beach](#) is located in Shorewood. It offers a large and beautiful beach where people are free to have picnics, swim, and explore the shoreline of Lake Michigan. (Free)

5 LAKESHORE STATE PARK

Located on the shores of Lake Michigan, [Lakeshore State Park](#) offers fishing and jogging paths that wind around the lake. The paths have a view of both the lake and the Milwaukee skyline. This is a beautiful place to bike, skate, and walk with friends! (vehicle admission - \$13)

BUBLR BIKE RIDES BY LAKE SIDE

Bublr Bikes are available across from Bradford Beach. These bikes are fairly inexpensive and perfect for exploring all that Milwaukee has to offer. (Single Pass-\$.25 per minute, Day Pass-\$24)



7 URBAN ECOLOGY CENTER

The Urban Ecology Center is a nonprofit organization in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. Their mission is to educate the Milwaukee community about the environment, conservation, sustainability, and other issues related to urban ecology, as well as to preserve and protect the natural areas in the city. They offer unique experiences throughout the city to seek community engagement. Join an early morning bird walk, a morning mindfulness session, and much more! There is a \$5 discount available for individual or family memberships. (free-\$5)

MILWAUKEE ZOO

This **Milwaukee County Zoo** is a prominent attraction in Wisconsin, and has almost every bird and animal imaginable, you would think. In fact, over 300 species dwell in this tranquil, lush green setting. (Less than \$15)

1 DISCOVERY WORLD

Discovery World is a nonprofit Science & Technology center that is dedicated to inspiring the next generation of STEM majors through curiosity and creativity. Visit the aquarium, innovation station, participate in the visual explorer with virtual reality and much more! There is a \$10 admission for Bigs and free for Littles. Please call to reserve your space. When you arrive, you will need to show your membership card. (Children \$16 and adults \$20)

MILWAUKEE PUBLIC MUSEUM

The Milwaukee Public Museum offers adventure for visitors with diverse interests. You can explore the Ice Age to look for a Saber-Toothed cat among the glaciers, see King Tut on his chariot in the Crossroads of Civilization exhibit, or interact with live butterflies as they flutter in the butterfly garden. You may also want to stop by the Dome Theater where you can get closer to the action. (Free first Thursday of every month)

3 UWM PLANETARIUM

Located at the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee, the **Manfred Olson Planetarium** offers a variety of programs to get familiar with the celestial world. Explore the birth of the universe, view the constellations, see a star show and much more! (\$5-6)

1 TURNERS CLIMBING GYM

Located across from the Fiserv Forum, [Turner Hall](#) offers an affordable and excellent climbing experience for all ages and climbing abilities. (Belay Certificate to Climb - \$20, Day Pass - \$10)

Matches get in for the price of one Day Pass with gear. Climbing equipment and a brief orientation are provided with the purchase of a Day Pass with Gear for both participants. The first member ("Big") is our normal EFT price (\$59/mo) while the second member ("Little") is our Second additional family member price (\$42/mo).
