Community-based mentoring is a traditional one-to-one mentoring program for Bigs and Littles to spend time together engaged in activities they choose based on shared interests. It provides fun & educational experiences, access to free events, and the opportunity to get involved in the community.

HOW IT WORKS:

- ❖ We carefully match a mentor "Big" with a child "Little" in Milwaukee or Waukesha county.
- Bigs in this program must be 21+, have access to transportation and auto insurance.
- Bigs commit to a minimum of a one year relationship. This ensures the children we serve have quality experiences and successful outcomes.
- Matches should meet 2-4 times a month for low to no cost activities.
- BBBS provides FREE group activities in collaboration with our community partners through our REACH Program - Recreation, Education & Careers, Arts & Culture, Civic Engagement, and Health & Fitness.

WHO ARE OUR LITTLES:

- A targeted population of youth ages 6-18 facing adversity throughout Milwaukee and Waukesha counties.
- Youth come from a variety of backgrounds and circumstances, and are generally enrolled in our program by their parent/guardian.
