
SCHOOL-BASED MENTORING



School-based mentoring is a facilitated one-to-one mentoring program for Bigs and Littles to meet weekly at a partner elementary or middle school location. This provides an exceptional learning opportunity for Littles and allows matches to work together to achieve educational goals.



HOW IT WORKS:

- Mentors are matched with an elementary or middle school student.
- ❖ Bigs must be 18+ and out of high school.
- ❖ Bigs commit to volunteering for at least one year during the school year.
- Matches have scheduled weekly meetings to help with homework, read, play games, and enjoy fun educational activities.
- BBBS hosts agency sponsored activities outside of the school setting where mentors and parents/guardians have the option to meet.



AS A MENTOR, YOU WILL:

- Help a child develop positive attitudes towards school.
- Help a child achieve higher grades.
- Help boost a child's confidence and improve their relationships with peers.
- Receive ongoing professional support from a dedicated BBBS staff member.
